## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 551.041vof Butters FRK Government Code, that the Navigation and Canal Commissioners of the VICTORIA. TEXAS COUNTY NAVIGATION DISTRICT (the "District") will meet on July 17, 2018, at 1:00 p.m. at the District's administrative office, located at 1934 FM 1432, Victoria, Texas.

The subjects of such meeting shall be:\*

- 1. Approval of minutes of the meeting held June 19, 2018.
- 2. To receive public comment (limited to three minutes per person).
- 3. To receive the following Staff and Committee reports:
- A. <u>Executive Director/Executive Committee</u> Business recruitment; development of the Port of Victoria North and South Industrial Site; leases and contracts; federal, state and local governmental affairs; rail issues; USACE update; upcoming Port and industry events; and other related administrative and governmental matters.
  - i) To review and consider a proposed Pipeline and Water Line Easement requested by Victoria Bloomington, LLC over property leased by said entity from the District, and take appropriate action.
  - ii) To review and consider a proposed Supplemental Easement and Right of Way requested by AEP Texas, Inc., supplementing a previous utility easement granted to Central Power and Light Company on August 16, 1949, and take appropriate action.
  - iii) To consider Staff recommendations regarding the transfer of revenue from operations to the District's Promotion and Development Fund, as authorized by Section Chapter 60 of the Texas Water Code, and take appropriate action.
- B. <u>Director of Port Operations</u> Activities and matters related to waterborne traffic activity; operations at the Port of Victoria; and Port tenant updates.
- C. <u>Finance Committee</u> Activities and matters related to financial results; investments; insurance; financial management issues; project financing; budgeting and tax rate analysis; and financial audit process.
  - i) Receipt of monthly financial reports, and approve payment of accounts payable.

- ii) To receive recommendations from Staff regarding a transfer and/or cancellation of the District's current credit card account, and take appropriate action.
- D. <u>Facilities Committee</u> Activities and matters related to the Channel to Victoria; capital and other projects; infrastructure, maintenance issues, and planning; transportation issues; safety and security measures; and other related engineering or environmental matters.
  - i) To receive information regarding the District's proposed BUILD Grant application, consider approval of proposed "matching funds" amounts contained therein, and take appropriate action.
- E. <u>Advancement & Development Committee</u> Activities and matters related to public affairs; industry meetings; Port presentations; Port events; trade and new customer development activities; advertising and web activity; Foreign-Trade Zone; and, other related trade development or community relations matters.
  - i) To receive a report from The Emmett Company regarding the potential development of the Port of Victoria facilities and properties, and strategic planning matters relating to the District.
  - ii) To receive an economic development report from representative(s) of the Victoria Economic Development Corporation (VEDC) and consider further action with respect to pending VEDC projects involving the Port of Victoria.
- 4. To receive the report of the District's Legal Counsel.
- 5. To discuss the status of negotiations with potential customers of the Port of Victoria and consider approval of agreements relating to same.
- 6. To discuss and deliberate the purchase, exchange or lease of property and other real estate matters, including requests for easements and/or permits.
- 7. To conduct the regular business of the Navigation District and that relating to its properties.
