 - To review and consider a proposed Second Amendment and Consent to Assignment of Ground Lease between the District and Enlink Midstream Operating, LP, granting an additional pipeline easement to said entity and authorizing an assignment of the Ground Lease and existing Port of Victoria Liquid Dock Operating Permit(s) to Victoria Express Pipeline, LLC (a related/subsidiary entity of Devon Gas Services, LP and Enlink Midstream Operating, LP), and take appropriate action.
 - iii) To authorize a one (1) year extension of the existing Agricultural Lease between the District, Delvin Hroch and Tomas Hroch, and authorize the Executive Director to execute same on behalf of the District.
