The subjects of such meeting shall be:

- 8) To meet with the District's engineering consultants regarding the status of the lift bridge automation project, and negotiations with Union Pacific Railroad and Port Vision, Inc., regarding same.
- 9) To discuss the status of negotiations with Caterpillar Inc. for the installation of a facility at the Port of Victoria.
- 10) To review the existing tariff rates for the Port of Victoria, and consider amendments, changes and additions to same, including implementation and enforcement of existing charges and fees.
- 11) To set a date for the District's Strategic Planning Conference.
- 12) To discuss the possible implementation of a security zone for the Port of Victoria and the Channel to Victoria.
- 13) To review and discuss expected legislative issues to be taken up in the next state legislative session.
