MEETING OF THE BOARD OF NAVIGATION AND CANAL COMMISSIONERS OF THE VICTORIA COUNTY NAVIGATION DISTRICT

The Board of Navigation and Canal Commissioners of the Victoria County Navigation District (the "District") convened on January 19, 2021, at 1:00 o'clock p.m., at the administrative offices of the District, 1934 FM 1432, Victoria, Texas, with the following Commission members present, to-wit: Robby Burdge, Byron Burris, Elton Calhoun, Don Pozzi, and John Gilley were present at the meeting. Also present at the meeting were Sean Stibich, Executive Director; Randy Insley, Operations Manager; Ben Galvan, District Engineer; Troy Stephens (CivilCorp); Duane Crocker, District Legal Counsel (via video-conference); Ed Emmett (The Emmett Company)(via video conference); and, Dale Fowler (VEDC).

Robby Burdge, Chairman, presided at the meeting. Noting that a quorum was present, the Chairman called the meeting to order and upon motions duly made, seconded, and adopted, the following proceedings were had:

- 1. The Commission approved minutes of the previous meetings held December 15, 2020 and January 11, 2021as submitted.
- 2. There was no public comment presented to the Commission.
- 3. The Commission approved a Services Agreement with Resolute Media Solutions, LLC in Victoria, Texas, for consulting services related to public relations, social media content, and other related matters.
- 4. The Commission extended the current fifteen cent per ton reduction to the District's frac sand tariff charge through June 30, 2021.
- 5. The Commission approved and ratified execution of a License Agreement with the United States Army Corps of Engineers for maintenance and operation of the Port of Victoria's South Industrial Site General Purpose Dock.
- 6. The Commission approved a letter of support for the Executive Director's application for nomination to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Maritime Administration (MARAD), U.S. Maritime Transportation System National Advisory Committee (MTSNAC), and authorized the Chairman to execute same on behalf of the District and the Board of Navigation and Canal Commissioners.
- 7. The Commission approved a proposed Memorandum of Understanding between the District, the City of Victoria, Victoria County, The Victoria Regional Airport, and The Victoria Sales Tax Development Corporation identifying the District's intentions with respect to a proposed mutually beneficial collaborative economic development initiative by the identified entities and authorized the Chairman to execute same on behalf of the District.
- 8. The Commission approved a short-term Grazing Lease with Mr. Don Elkins for the District's property located at 1088 Black Bayou Road #2 in Bloomington, Texas, and authorized the Executive Director to execute same.

- 9. The Commission approved submitted documents related to the award and administration of an EDA CARES Act grant recently awarded to the District for the South Industrial Site Rail Loop Project and authorized the execution of same.
- 10. The Commission received a presentation from VEDC's Dale Fowler regarding that organization's marketing efforts made on behalf of the District and plans for future such efforts, and thereafter, acting on the recommendation of the District's Executive Committee, approved continuation of the District's relationship with VEDC on a month-to-month basis under the terms of the District's existing contract with VEDC.
- 11. The Commission approved an Access Agreement with Southern Rock Energy Partners allowing due diligence access to specified portions of the Port of Victoria's South Industrial Site and authorized the execution of same.
- 12. The Commission authorized the solicitation of letters of interest and statements of qualifications from railroad and terminal operating service companies for rail operations, switching services, and/or the joint development and operation of a proposed rail, barge, and truck terminal at the Port of Victoria's Industrial Site(s).
- 13. The Commission received a report from Operations Manager Randy Insley, which included a year-end commodities report for 2020.
- 14. The Commission received, reviewed, and approved financial reports for the month of December 2020.
- 15. The Commission ratified and approved the payment of accounts payable through January 19, 2021 in the amount of \$275,389.80, with \$253,644.71 payable from the District's Operating Account, and \$21,745.09 payable from the Promotion & Development Fund.
- 16. The Commission approved the attached Budget Amendments for FY 2020.
- 17. The Commission authorized the solicitation of construction bids for the Rider 45 Project which will expand and improve McCoy Road and Bayer Road.
- 18. The Commission authorized the solicitation of construction bids for the Rider 38 Project which involves the expansion, improvement, and installation of a queuing land and lighting on the roadway leading to the Port of Victoria's North Industrial Site General Dock.
- 19. The Commission received a report from District Engineer Ben Galvan which included: (i) an update on Union Pacific Rail Road's review of submitted design work related to a planned rail loop project at the Port of Victoria North Industrial Site; and, (ii) an update on the ongoing appeal process related to FEMA's preliminary flood plain maps.

- 20. The Commission received a report from Ed Emmett which included information regarding: (i) ongoing planning for the District's 2021 Strategic Planning Conference set to take place February 28 through March 02, 2021 in Austin; (ii) information related to the tracking of new federal administration appointees; and, (iii) plans for an increased District presence at upcoming rail transportation conferences.
- 21. The Chairman recessed the public meeting and reconvened the Commission into executive session pursuant to Section 551.087 and 551.072 of the Texas Government Code to discuss economic development matters and matters related to real property.
- 22. The Chairman reconvened the public meeting and there was no action taken by the Commission following the Executive Sessions.

There was no further business to come before the Commission, and the Chairman announced that the meeting was adjourned.

We are pleased to confirm our understanding of the services we are to provide the Victoria County Navigation District (the "District") for the year ended December 31, 2020. We will audit the financial statements of the governmental activities and each major fund, including the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the basic financial statements of the District as of and for the year ended December 31, 2020. Accounting standards generally accepted in the United States of America provide for certain required supplementary information (RSI), such as management's discussion and analysis (MD&A), to supplement the District's basic financial statements. Such information, although not a part of the basic financial statements, is required by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board who considers it to be an essential part of financial reporting for placing the basic financial statements in an appropriate operational, economic, or historical context. As part of our engagement, we will apply certain limited procedures to the District's RSI in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. These limited procedures will consist of inquiries of management regarding the methods of preparing the information and comparing the information for consistency with management's responses to our inquiries, the basic financial statements, and other knowledge we obtained during our audit of the basic financial statements. We will not express an opinion or provide any assurance on the information because the limited procedures do not provide us with sufficient evidence to express an opinion or provide any assurance. The following RSI is required by generally accepted accounting principles and will be subjected to certain limited procedures, but will not be audited:

- 1. Management's Discussion and Analysis
- 2. Budgetary Comparison Schedule General Fund

Audit Objective

The objective of our audit is the expression of opinions as to whether your basic financial statements are fairly presented, in all material respects, in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles and to report on the fairness of the supplementary information referred to in the second paragraph when considered in relation to the financial statements taken as a whole. Our audit will be conducted in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and will include tests of the accounting records and other procedures we consider necessary to enable us to express such opinions. We will issue a written report upon completion of our audit of the District's financial statements. Our report will be addressed to the Board of Directors of the District. We cannot provide assurance that unmodified opinions will be expressed. Circumstances may arise in which it is necessary for us to modify our opinions or add emphasis-of-matter or other-matter paragraphs. If our opinions on the financial statements are other than unqualified, we will fully discuss the reasons with you in advance. If, for any reason, we are unable to complete the audit or are unable to form or have not formed opinions, we may decline to express opinions or to issue a report as a result of this engagement.

Audit Procedures - General

An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements; therefore, our audit will involve judgment about the number of transactions to be examined and the areas to be tested. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements. We will plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable rather than absolute assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement, whether from (1) errors, (2) fraudulent financial reporting, (3) misappropriation of assets, or (4) violations of laws or governmental regulations that are attributable to the entity or to acts by management or employees acting on behalf of the entity.

Because of the inherent limitations of an audit, combined with the inherent limitations of internal control, and because we will not perform a detailed examination of all transactions, there is a risk that material misstatements may exist and not be detected by us, even though the audit is properly planned and performed in accordance with U.S. generally accepted auditing standards. In addition, an audit is not designed to detect immaterial misstatements or violations of laws or governmental regulations that do not have a direct and material effect on the financial statements. However, we will inform the appropriate level of management of any material errors, any fraudulent financial reporting, or misappropriation of assets that comes to our attention. We will also inform the appropriate level of management of any violations of laws or governmental regulations that come to our attention, unless clearly inconsequential. Our responsibility as auditors is limited to the period covered by our audit and does not extend to any later periods for which we are not engaged as auditors.

Our procedures will include tests of documentary evidence supporting the transactions recorded in the accounts, and may include direct confirmation of receivables and certain other assets and liabilities by correspondence with selected individuals, funding sources, creditors, and financial institutions. We will request written representations from your attorneys as part of the engagement, and they may bill you for responding to this inquiry. At the conclusion of our audit, we will also require certain written representations from you about the financial statements and related matters.

Audit Procedures - Internal Control

Our audit will include obtaining an understanding of the entity and its environment, including internal control, sufficient to assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements and to design the nature, timing, and extent of further audit procedures. An audit is not designed to provide assurance on internal control or to identify deficiencies in internal control. However, during the audit, we will communicate to management and those charged with governance internal control related matters that are required to be communicated under AICPA professional standards.

Audit Procedures - Compliance

As part of obtaining reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement, we will perform tests of the District's compliance with the provisions of applicable laws, regulations, contracts, and agreements. However, the objective of our audit will not be to provide an opinion on overall compliance and we will not express such an opinion.

Other Services

We will also prepare the financial statements and related notes of the District in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles based on information provided by you and propose adjusting or correcting journal entries to be reviewed and approved by management. We will perform the services in accordance with applicable professional standards. The other services are limited to the services previously defined. We, in our sole professional judgment, reserve the right to refuse to perform or take any action that could be construed as assuming management responsibilities.

Management Responsibilities

Management is responsible for establishing and maintaining effective internal controls, including monitoring ongoing activities; for the selection and application of accounting principles; and for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles.

Management is also responsible for making all financial records and related information available to us and for the accuracy and completeness of that information. You are also responsible for providing us with (1) access to all information of which you are aware that is relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements, (2) additional information that we may request for the purpose of the audit, and (3) unrestricted access to persons within the District from whom we determine it necessary to obtain audit evidence.

Your responsibilities include adjusting the financial statements to correct material misstatements and confirming to us in the management representation letter that the effects of any uncorrected misstatements aggregated by us during the current engagement and pertaining to the latest period presented are immaterial, both individually and in the aggregate, to the financial statements taken as a whole.

You are responsible for the design and implementation of programs and controls to prevent and detect fraud, and for informing us about all known or suspected fraud affecting the District involving (1) management, (2) employees who have significant roles in internal control, and (3) others where the fraud could have a material effect on the financial statements. Your responsibilities include informing us of your knowledge of any allegations of fraud or suspected fraud affecting the District received in communications from employees, former employees, regulators, or others. In addition, you are responsible for identifying and ensuring that the District complies with applicable laws and regulations.

You are responsible for the preparation of the supplementary information in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles. You agree to include our report on the supplementary information in any document that contains and indicates that we have reported on the supplementary information. You also agree to include the audited financial statements with any presentation of the supplementary information that includes our report thereon OR make the audited financial statements readily available to users of the supplementary information no later than the date the supplementary information is issued with our report thereon. Your responsibilities include acknowledging to us in the representation letter that (1) you are responsible for presentation of the supplementary information in accordance with GAAP; (2) you believe the supplementary information, including its form and content, is fairly presented in accordance with GAAP; (3) the methods of measurement or presentation have not changed from those used in the prior period (or, if they have changed, the reasons for such changes); and (4) you have disclosed to us any significant assumptions or interpretations underlying the measurement of presentation of the supplementary information.

You agree to assume all management responsibilities for financial statement presentation services and any other nonattest services we provide; oversee the services by designating an individual, preferable from senior management, with suitable skill, knowledge, or experience; evaluate the adequacy and results of the services; and accept responsibility for them.

Engagement Administration, Fees, and Other

We understand that your employees will prepare all cash or other confirmations we request and will locate any invoices selected by us for testing.

We expect to begin our audit during the month of April 2021 and to issue our reports no later than June 2021. Mr. Stephen W. Van Manen, CPA is the engagement partner and is responsible for supervising the engagement and signing the report or authorizing another individual to sign it.

Our fees for these services will be based on the actual time spent at our standard hourly rates, plus travel and other out-of-pocket costs such as report production, typing, postage, etc. Our standard hourly rates vary according to the degree of responsibility involved and the experience level of the personnel assigned to your audit. Based on our preliminary estimates, the fee should not exceed \$11,950. This estimate is based on anticipated cooperation from your personnel and the assumption that unexpected circumstances will not be encountered during the audit. If significant additional time is necessary, we will discuss this with you and arrive at a new fee estimate before we incur the additional costs.
