NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 551.041 of the Texas Government Code, that the Navigation and Canal Commissioners of the Victoria County Navigation District (the "District") will meet on March 25, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. at the District's administrative office, located at 1934 FM 1432, Victoria, Texas.

The subjects of such meeting shall be:*

- 1. Approval of minutes of the meetings held February 18 and March 3-5, 2025.
- 2. To receive public comment (limited to three minutes per person).
- 3. To receive the following Staff and Committee reports:
- A. Executive Director/Executive Committee Business recruitment; development of the Port of Victoria North and South Industrial Sites; leases and contracts; real estate matters; federal, state, and local governmental affairs; rail issues; USACE matters and updates; upcoming Port and industry events; Port tenant/customer updates; and other related operational, administrative, and governmental matters.
- B. Operations Manager Activities and matters related to waterborne traffic activity; security matters; and operations at the Port of Victoria.
- C. Finance Committee Activities and matters related to financial status and results; investments; insurance; financial management issues; project financing; budgeting and tax rate analysis; and financial audit process.
 - To receive the monthly financial reports of the District and approve i) accounts payable.
 - To receive, review, and consider approval of a proposed transfer of ii) \$192,287.71 from the General Operating account to the Promotion & Development account, to be effective April 01, 2025.
 - To receive, review, and consider approval of proposed budget (iii amendments for FY 2025 for the District's Operating Fund, the Texas Logistics Center Fund, and the Promotion and Development Fund.
- D. Facilities Committee Activities and matters related to the Channel to Victoria; capital and other projects; infrastructure, maintenance issues, infrastructure planning and development; transportation issues; safety and security measures; and other related engineering or environmental matters.

- i) To receive and review bid tabulations and related information pertaining to bids received for construction of the Port of Victoria South Industrial Site Rail Build-Out Project, consider recommendations from Staff, the District Engineer, and consultants related to same, including the potential acceptance or rejection of specific bids and awarding of an appropriate contract in keeping with said recommendations, and take appropriate action.
- ii) To receive information and consider authorization of the solicitation of bids for the Seaport Connectivity Project, including the construction of transload roads within the Port of Victoria North Industrial Site, and take appropriate action.
- E. <u>Advancement & Development Committee</u> Activities and matters related to public affairs; industry meetings; Port presentations; Port events; trade and new customer development activities; advertising and web activity; Foreign-Trade Zone; and other related trade development or community relations matters.
 - i) To receive a report from The Emmett Company regarding potential development of the Port of Victoria's facilities and properties, and strategic planning matters relating to the District.
 - ii) To receive an economic development report from representative(s) of the Victoria Economic Development Corporation (VEDC) and consider further action with respect to pending VEDC projects involving the Port of Victoria.
- 4. To receive the report of the District's Legal Counsel.
 - i) To receive an update and consult with the District's Legal Counsel on pending litigation matters related to the District's South Industrial Site Rail Build-Out Project.
